The Basics

Roles

Facilitators of both adult and school support groups:

- Clarify the purpose of the group; lead the session
- Gently encourage each member to "tell their story"
- Communicate group ground rules - vital for safety
- Model nonjudgmental acceptance, compassionate listening, and welcoming
- Facilitate logistics

Qualifications:

These apply for facilitating in-person or virtually:

- Must be at least 18 years old
- Must have a valid drivers license
- Be able to work as a team member
- Agree to criminal background check prior to assuming duties
- Be trustworthy to work in a confidential environment

Time Commitment

- Ready to commit to at least one (1) year of volunteering approximately 3 hours per month
- Attend 5-6 hours of training with our bereavement team
- Attend check-in meetings on a regular basis with bereavement team
